He won't empty it – He'll fill it.*



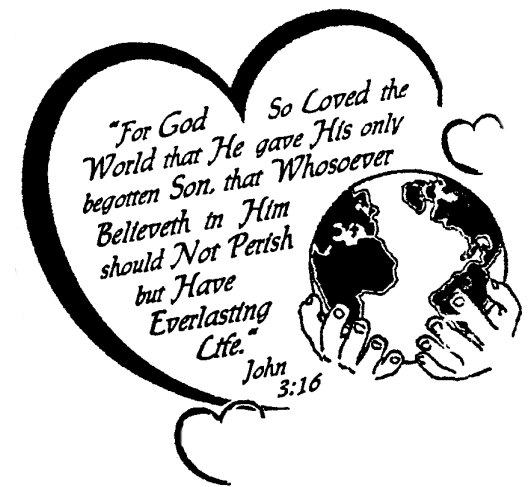

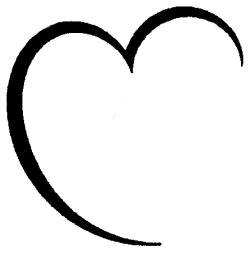
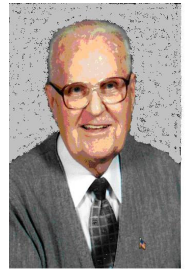

-Jer. 17:10

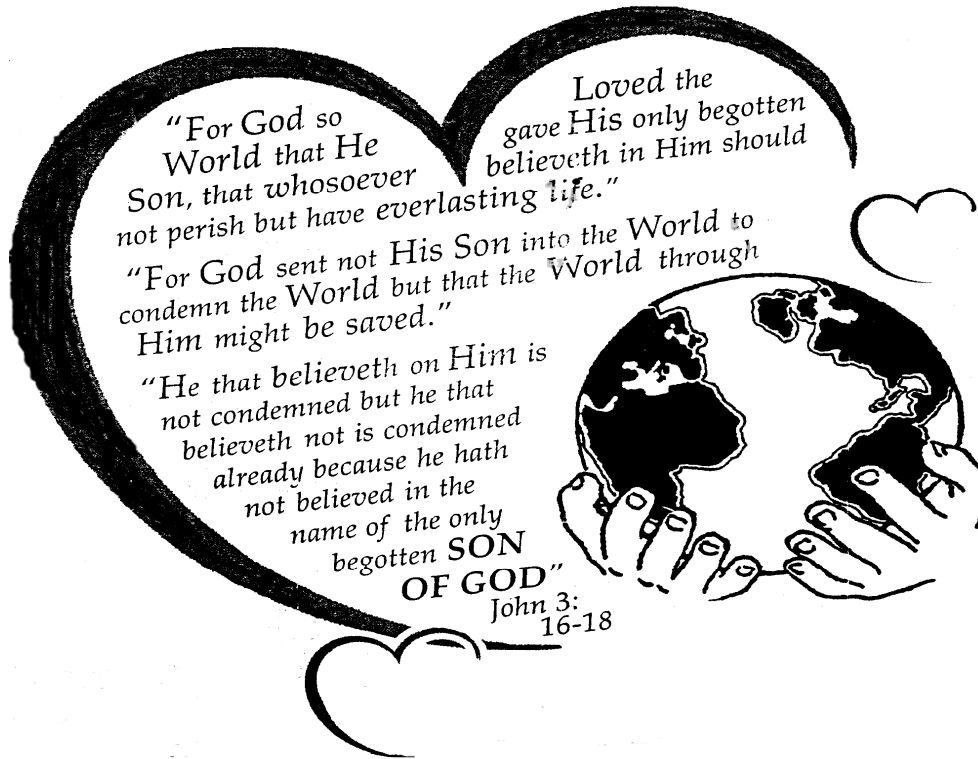
He heals broken hearts.
