ANGER – HOSTILITY

PROVERBS

- 14:17 "He that is soon angry deals foolishly..."
 - Some people say things they haven't even thought of yet.
- 15:1 "A soft answer turns away wrath: but grievous words stir up anger."
 - Taste your words before allowing them to pass your teeth.
- 15:18 "A wrathful man stirs up strife: but he that is slow to anger appeases strife."
 - Trained trouble-makers are on the loose everywhere.
- 16:32 "He that is slow to anger is better than the mighty; and he that rules his spirit than he that takes a city."
 - Self control in a person's life in the eyes of the Lord is of more importance than a mighty conqueror.
- 22:24 "Make no friendship with an angry man; and with a furious man thou shalt not go."
 - Steer clear of fellowshipping with hot-headed, quick-tempered individuals.
- 29:22 "An angry man stirs up strife, and a furious man abounds in transgression."
 - Anyone living on hate is a sick person.

The following are some thoughtful quotes to challenge your thinking:

- When angry count to ten before you speak. If very angry, count to one hundred.
- The fire you kindle for your enemy often burns yourself more than him. (Chinese Proverb)
- A man makes his inferiors his superiors by heat. (R. W. Emerson)
- *The greatest remedy for anger is delay. (Seneca)*
- The angry man is again angry with himself when he returns to reason.
