

Evaluation of a Pastor or Elder

Clarification of Terms:

1) An ELDER is a man up in years or full grown in years; hence he is a man full-grown, mature, discerning, experienced in the things of God, a seasoned veteran in the spiritual realm.

2) A PASTOR (or BISHOP) is an overseer, or one who superintends or watches over the flock (Acts 20:29; 1 Peter 5:1-4).

4). "Elder" would point to the man; "Bishop" would point to the man's work (or office). The two terms are equated in Titus 1:5, 7, as they both describe the same office.
