

# SPUNK IN A SPINELESS AGE

### INTRODUCTION:

## <u>In Jacob's case</u> it had to do with

"I will not let thee go, except thou bless me." Genesis 32:26

Jacob, a finite being, talking to our infinite God in such a manner. Imagine a walking dustpile (Gen 2:7) like Jacob talking to the Creator as he did. Jacob had done a lot of wrong things in his life, but in his heart he kept inching up God, and God Who searches the hearts of men (Jer 17:10) knew it. What a wrestling match! # SHAME

# In Mose's case it had to do with SHAME:

"Yet now, if thou wilt forgive their sin, and if not, blot me, I pray thee, out of thy book which thou hast written." Exodus 32:32

Had God listened to Moses in granting his request to the fullest by blotting him out, we would have been minus some books of the Bible which Moses wrote. An ultimatum was delivered to God by Moses. Spunk! God honored the heart cry of Moses in His way. We need to cry out to God today, not only for the shame of America in a time when the good guys seem to be wearing the black hats and the bad guys are wearing white hats, but also in our Christian circles where compromise has set in, in the church and at home. # In Paul's case it had to do with **SALVATION**:
