GOD KNOWS OUR THOUGHTS

"...no thought can be witholden from Thee." Job 42:2

"... Thou understandest my thought afar off." Psalm 139:2

God knows our thoughts? Why not? The Bible tells us that He created us and that we are fearfully and wonderfully made – Psalm 139:14.

GOD ISSUES A COMMAND TO THE BELIEVER ON RIGHT THINKING

GOD HONORS THOSE WHO INCLUDE HIM IN THEIR THINKING

Joseph experienced a visitation from the GOD because of right thinking. We can be blessed of GOD in having HIM speak to us as we include HIM in our thinking. Note: 1 Samuel 2:30
