



Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

Acts 4:12

Solemn news in Acts 4:12. Impossible to attain salvation through church membership, baptism, good works, etc. – see Ephesians 2:8-9, Titus 3:5. Salvation comes by calling on HIS NAME AND ASKING HIM to save you – Romans 10:13 Everything else aside from calling on Him by faith is referred to as filthy rags by God – see Isaiah 64:6.

Neither give heed to fables and endless genealogies, which minister questions, rather than godly edifying which is in faith: so do.

I Timothy 1:4

Neither as being lords over God's heritage, but being examples to the flock.

I Peter 5:3

One translation puts it this way, "you should not aim at being little tin gods." The great leader, a dictator says, "frog" and everyone is suppose to jump. No! Leaders among God's congregations are needed today who are selfless, Leaders who teach by living. Leaders with a heart for GOD, HIS WORD, and HIS PEOPLE.

*Neither give place to the devil.* Ephesians 4:27

The challenge in the context is that believers are not to keep nursing a grudge against one another as it would result in not only sinning against GOD, but ending up in the believer's life with a physical ailment, the devil having the victory and the believer then facing GOD for it at the Judgment Seat of Christ. See II Cor 2: 10,11 and II Cor 5:10. Say YES to GOD and NO to the devil.
