Evaluation of a Pastor or Elder

Clarification of Terms:

- 1) An ELDER is a man up in years or full grown in years; hence he is a man full-grown, mature, discerning, experienced in the things of God, a seasoned veteran in the spiritual realm.
- 2) A PASTOR (or BISHOP) is an overseer, or one who superintends or watches over the flock (Acts 20:29; 1 Peter 5:1-
- 4). "Elder" would point to the man; "Bishop" would point to the man's work (or office). The two terms are equated in Titus 1:5, 7, as they both describe the same office.

OF GOOD BEHAVIOR The pastor has an orderly, organized, well-ordered life, and does not live in chaos. The pastor demonstrated good stewardship in his giving and spending habits. The pastor exhibits a life-style of good planning and purpose.
GIVEN TO HOSPITALITY The pastor has had people from the <u>church</u> over to his <u>home</u> for fellowship in the past. The pastor has an open heart towards the ministry to others <u>outside</u> of the fellowship. The pastor is believed to be a vital part of the home and hospital <u>visitation</u> program.
APT TO TEACH The pastor is able, skilled and willing to teach the Word of God. The pastor appears to be very versed and knowledgeable in the Old and New Testament. The pastor appears to read or study his Bible just about every day of the week. The pastor is a good communicator of God's truth as found in the Bible. The pastor has committed and is continually committing a lot of Scripture to memory.
