Pitfalls in Ministry – Traps and Dangers

- 1. Neglect of one's spiritual life.
- 2. Failure to *delegate* responsibilities.
- 3. Unbalanced and *lopsided* ministry. Beware of "hobby horses" and bad interpretation.
- 4. Failure to distinguish between the *theological* and the *applicable*.
- 5. Failure to realize that we are "Shepherds."
- 6. Beware the trap of "unguarded" counsel.
- 7. Failure to gain *respect* before making *changes*.
- 8. The trap of accepting a *position* that is *not* a good fit.
- 9. Not preaching the *whole counsel* of God; having an *unhealthy* desire for a *large ministry*.
- 10. The trap of being a workaholic.
- 11. The trap of *neglecting* your *family*.
- 12. Failure to *practice* what you *preach*.
- 13. The trap of being too *rigid* at critical times.
- 14. The trap of bordering on *legalism*.
- 15. Beware of trying to *please* everybody.
- 16. Beware of ministering under the wrong motivation.
- 17. Do not operate as a "Protestant Pope."
- 18. Absolutely do <u>not</u> handle the ministry's *finances*.
- 19. Failure to keep *keeping up* with the study and current events of the day.
- 20. Avoid *pride* and *false* humility.
- 21. Stagnation beware of intellectual stagnation.
- 22. Beware of the pressure to *compromise*.
- 23. Beware the trap of *sexual compromise*; be accountable regarding counsel of women and internet usage.
- 24. Beware the "Lone Ranger" trap; build close confidents into ministry that will give truthful assessment of harmful ministry practices.
