When Retreating Pays Dividends

We're living in a time with great emphasis on the idea of moving ahead and never retreating. I love the hymn with the words in it, "NEVER GIVE UP", and am also a firm believer in what those words tell us. I do believe that in order to NEVER GIVE UP it also entails sometimes a time of RETREATING in the Christian life. Yours truly spent 37 months overseas in World War II, and participated in four invasions on the European Continent. I also participated in a hurried retreat in France while there, in order to come back later in victory. Note as we make some running comments on a few verses in Proverbs having to do with RETREATING in the Christian life:

- 1. 4:27 "Turn not to the right hand nor to the left: remove thy foot from evil."
 - BACK OFF and continue to back off from that which would ruin you spiritually.
- 2. 10:19 "In the multitude of words there wanteth not sin: but he that refrains his lips is wise."
 - <u>HOLD OFF</u> of non-stop talking. Don't speak unless you can improve on the silence. Some talk like they have been vaccinated with a phonograph needle.
- 3. 14:7 "Go from the presence of a foolish man, when thou perceivest not in him the lips of knowledge."
 - TAKE OFF from the presence of one showing his disrespect for GOD if you are in HIS PRESENCE for learning. Such a person is setting himself up for a date with GOD over among other things, accountable words. Matthew 12:37
- 4. 22:3 "A prudent man foresees the evil, and hides himself: but the simple pass on, and are punished."
 - <u>RUN OFF</u> and hide from that which will endanger your testimony. Don't be a SIMPLETON by closing your eyes to the consequences of enjoying the pleasures of sin for a season.
- 5. 24:21 "My son, fear thou the LORD and the king: and meddle not with them that are given to change."
 - <u>LEAVE OFF</u> of those who discard the Bible's old fashioned time-proven ways for supposed helpful changes, else you will end up like the Australian who threw away his boomerang for a new one only to have it come back and kill him.
